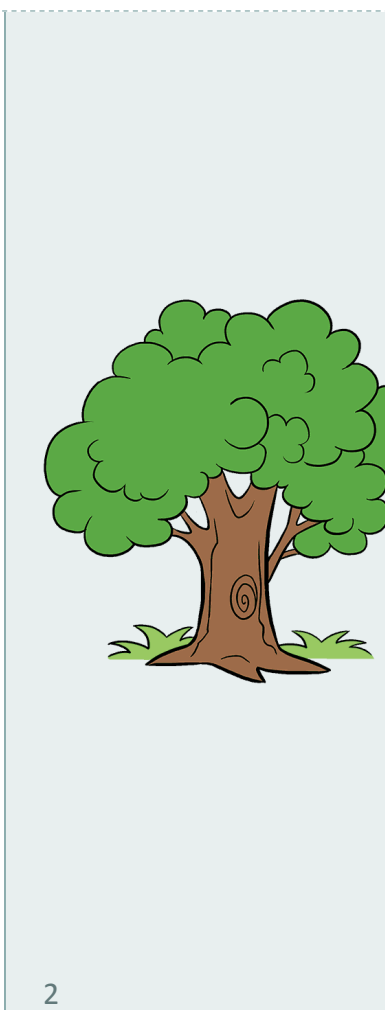


MEMORY JOGGER
